FAQ's

What is the Oliver McGowan Mandatory Training on Learning Disability and Autism?

The Oliver McGowan Mandatory Training is now mandated by the Oliver McGowan Draft Code of Practice. It has been designed to ensure health and social care staff receive appropriate training in learning disability and autism. It was developed following the tragic death of Oliver McGowan and aims to improve understanding, communication, and care for autistic people and people with a learning disability.

Who needs to complete this training?

All staff working in health and social care settings are required to complete the Oliver McGowan Mandatory Training at a level appropriate to them – either Tier 1 or Tier 2 – which is based on their role.

What are the differences between Tier 1 and Tier 2 training?

Tier 1 is for staff who require general awareness, such as administrative staff, while Tier 2 is for those who provide direct care or support. Tier 2 is a face-to-face interactive session co-delivered by trainers with lived experience.

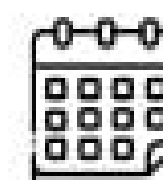
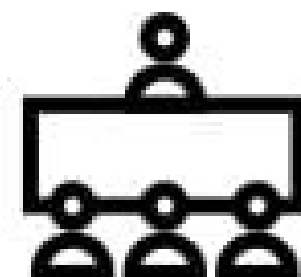
